great theologian described it thus: “The unique Ark of Salvation must welcome all human diversity into its vast nave. The only banquet hall, the food it distributes is drawn from all of creation. The seamless garment of Christ, it is also – and it is the same thing – the garment of Joseph, with its many colors”. [3]

It is a great sign of hope – especially in our times, traversed by so many conflicts and wars – to know that the Church is a people in which women and men of different nationalities, languages and cultures live together in faith: it is a sign placed in the very heart of humanity, a reminder and prophecy of that unity and peace to which God the Father calls all his children.

The Via Dolorosa (sometimes called “the Way of Suffering”) is a route located in the Old City of Jerusalem which follows the route that Jesus is believed to have walked on his way to be crucified (From Gethsemane to Calvary). The route follows the traditional 14 Stations of the Cross.
